Pro Circuit Platinum Pipe Award - JALEK SWOLL

Awarded to the rider in all divisions (divisions 1-13) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross

Scott Golden Goggle Award - REG MAGYAR

Awarded to the rider in the Amateur (b&C) class divisions (divisions 8-11) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross.

Dunlop Silver Tire Award -DARIAN SANAYEI

Awarded to the rider in the Pro/A class divisions (divisions 12-13) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross.

Fox Bronze Boot Award - JALEK SWOLL

Awarded to the rider in the Youth class divisions (65cc, 85cc, Mini Sr, Supermini, and Schoolboy classes - division 1-7) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross.

Vet Masters Award - JOHN GREWE

Sr 45+, Masters 50+, and Masters 55+) that accumulates the highest number of points combined in both supercross and motocross.

Diamond Award - JAMISON DUCLOS

This award recognizes a rider who exemplifies late Jantz Grodzicki's love and dedication to the motocross sport. This award will be presented to a "B" or "C" rider that creates a positive impact, is humble, acts as a role model for others, and represents his/her sponsors well.
