## SPECIALTY AWARD RECIPIENTS

<b>JETT REYNOLDS</b>	<b>Pro Circuit Platinum Pipe Award</b> - Awarded to the rider in all divisions (divisions 1-13) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross.
<b>STOCKTON STINEBAUGH</b>	<b>Scott Golden Goggle Award</b> - Awarded to the rider in the Amateur (B & C) class divisions (division 8-11) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross.
<b>CARTER HALPAIN</b>	<b>Dunlop Silver Tire Award</b> - Awarded to the rider in the Pro/A class divisions (division 12-13) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross.
<b>JETT REYNOLDS</b>	<b>THOR Bronze Boot Award</b> - Awarded to the rider in the Youth class divisions (65cc, 85cc, Mini Sr., Supermini, and Schoolboy classes - division 1-7) that accumulates the highest number of points, combined in both supercross and motocross.
<b>JOHN GREWE</b>	<b>Vet Masters Award</b> – Awarded to the rider in the Vet, Senior and Masters classes non-divisions (Junior 25+, Vet 30+, Vet 35+, Sr 40+, Sr 45+, Masters 50+, and Masters 55+) that accumulates the highest number of points combined in both supercross and motocross.
